

PSYCHIATRY FELLOWSHIP POSITIONS

Applications are now being accepted for Psychiatry Fellowships in the Department of Psychosocial Oncology and Palliative Care at Princess Margaret Hospital (PMH) in Toronto, Canada. Affiliated with the University of Toronto, PMH is a large comprehensive cancer centre with a focus on excellence in clinical care, education and research.

Applicants must have completed postgraduate training and obtained specialist qualifications in Psychiatry. Fellows will join a rich and stimulating multidisciplinary clinical and academic environment, building expertise in the psychosocial and psychiatric care of patients with cancer, and developing academic expertise in the field.

For one-year fellowships the academic focus is on clinical education. Mentorship and training will be provided to allow candidates to become clinician educators in the field of psychosocial oncology. For two-year fellowships the academic focus is on research. These fellows will join a large productive research team focused on the psychosocial aspects of advanced cancer; psychotherapeutic interventions in this population; the quality of death and dying; and bereavement morbidity.
