- Must be eligible for provisional or regular licensure from the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Saskatchewan (CPSS) www.cps.sk.ca
- Coverage with the Canadian Medical Protective Association (CMPA) is required www.cmpa-acpm.ca
- Applicants must have successfully achieved their English Language Proficiency (IELTS) and the Medical Council of Canada Evaluating Exam (MCCEE) as requirements for licensure with the CPSS

- In accordance with immigration requirements, preference will be given to Canadian citizens and permanent residents of Canada.
