

General Adult Psychiatrist Mental Health and Addictions Program Eastern Health

Eastern Health invites applications for the position of General Adult Psychiatrist with the Mental Health and Addictions Program of Eastern Health, in affiliation with Memorial University of Newfoundland. This position is available effective immediately and is a full time permanent position.

Eastern Health is the largest integrated health organization in Newfoundland and Labrador. It employs over 13,000 employees and provide services to a regional population of more than 300,000. Eastern Health has unique provincial responsibilities for tertiary level institutional services.

The Physician will join an established group of Psychiatrists who work within the multidisciplinary teams of the Mental Health and Addictions Program. This position includes opportunities for:

- 1. Consultation and collaborative care to Eastern Health facilities.
- 2. Providing Psychiatric care to individuals within Correctional Facilities.
- 3. Outpatient Clinic Capacity, participation in Centralized Intake for Psychiatry, including the potential for tele-psychiatry, and help with a shared care model of practice.
- 4. There may be an opportunity of participating in a FACT Team.
- 5. Participation in the General Adult on call system.
- 6. It would be an asset but not a necessity to have an interest in Addiction Medicine and hold a Methadone Prescribing License.

Interests in Shared Care, Medical Quality and Efficiency, Addictions and Clinical teaching would be assets to the successful applicant.

Normal working hours are 8:30am to 4:30pm, Monday to Friday. On-Call is currently divided amongst a group of approximately 25 physicians on a point equalization system.

There is no overhead with office and administrative support included. Salary and benefits for this position are to be paid in accordance with the Memorandum of Understanding for salaried physicians in Newfoundland and Labrador.

Applicants must hold a Medical Degree, an FRCPC (or equivalent) in Psychiatry and be eligible for licensure in the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Newfoundland and Labrador.
